### **KINDERGARTEN WALKING REPORT CARD**

Just a reminder...state law prohibits children from administering their own medications at school. Students should not “hand carry” any medications to and from school. Medications should not be kept in the classroom or in a child’s backpack unless it is an inhaler for asthma. If your child needs to take a prescription medication or even an over-the-counter med such as Tylenol or Advil, etc. during school hours, parents must bring the medication to school and fill out applicable paper work that allows the office staff to administer the medication at school. This procedure is for the safety of all students.
