### **Covid Update**

### **School Picture Re-take/Make-up Day**

Picture re-take/make-up day is this Thursday, January 14, 8:30-9:30 a.m.

- If you bought a packet and are not pleased with the first picture, please *send the packet back to school with your child on re-take day, Jan. 14* and they can turn it in to the photographer in order to get a new picture taken.
- If your child didn't get their picture taken on the first picture day, we will take their picture on re-take day so they can be part of the class composite. You may also purchase picture packets on re-take day.

- If your child is participating in online learning only, then you have the option to bring your child in to get their picture taken or not. If you do not have their picture taken, your child will not be included with the class composite picture for the year.
  - For those that purchase a class picture, those will be sent home in a few weeks.

### **Intent to Return Form**

Each January we ask our CRA families if they plan to have their child/children return to CRA for the following school year. This helps us to know how many students will be staying with us (we hope all of them!) and how many students will be leaving at the end of this school year. We plan to send home a printed "Intent to Return" form (on bright yellow paper) with the oldest child in each family. If your child is online only, teachers will be putting the forms in with your child's weekly work that you pick up at the school. 2021-2022 Registration Information:

\*Students must be 4 years old by September 1, 2021 and eligible to attend Kindergarten the following year.

\*4-day preschool program- Monday through Thursday.

\*Class time: 8:30 - 11:15 a.m.

\*Tuition: \$225.00 per month- due on the first day of each month.

\*Registration Fee: \$35.00 (non-refundable).

\*There is no uniform policy for Pre-school.

\*18 students, 2 teachers and hoping to have 1 or more parent volunteers each day. We count on parents to help us in the classroom 7-8 times during the year. This can be a mom, dad, or grandparent. Parent volunteers make all the difference!

Students are accepted on a first come, first served basis. No early registration forms accepted.
