Four Day Attendance Schedule:

Halloween Parade

Since we announced the parade on Oct. 12th, the state has implemented new guidelines for gatherings. We can still hold the parade subject to "organizational oversight" for gathering safely - https://coronavirus.utah.gov/utah-health-guidance-levels/

Conditions for all involved:

- Attendees and students must wear a mask unless they are less than three years old.
- Costume masks that cover the nose and mouth are not allowed unless it is an approved cloth mask that could be worn at school (the mask can have a Halloween theme).
- Attendees are required to maintain six feet of physical distance between individuals from separate households.
- Attendees must sign in upon entering school grounds through the tennis courts or south walkway (clipboards provided) and stand in the area assigned by school personnel. No school access is allowed.
- We will send home a schedule later this week with the times that different grade levels may participate in the parade.

Air Filtration Units

In addition to the safety measures that are already in place at CRA to ensure your child's safety while they attend school, the Air Filtration Units we ordered arrived last week. These units have been placed in every classroom and rooms in the school where children congregate. CRA has invested \$15,000 to purchase these filtration units. We are continually studying the science behind the COVID-19 virus and are aware that it spreads through airborne droplets and aerosols. These portable air purifiers provide medical grade HEPA filtration and address the complete spectrum of air cleaning, removing sub-micron particles passing through a 4 stage filter. As classroom windows will be closed with the change of seasons, these filters will be useful to reduce exposures to airborne droplets and aerosols that may be emitted and provide clean air in the classroom and school.
