### **Vision Screening at CRA**

The State Health department requires that we conduct a Vision Screening for students in Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades. A Vision Screening is not a thorough eye exam as would be conducted in a doctor's office, but it can often identify vision problems that affect a student's ability to learn.
