Some Things to Know...

As we navigate the changes that COVID has brought about in the school, we have a few reminders that we'd like to share with you:

- Please make sure that your child feels completely well before leaving for school each morning. If they don't feel well during the school day, then we will call the parent and the child will need to be taken home. This will help mitigate any illness being passed at school.
- If your child is ill and you believe they may have been exposed to someone with COVID, has COVID or COVID symptoms, please notify the office so that we can track the illness. If your child isn't showing symptoms of illness but has been exposed to someone with COVID 19, please let us know. There are protocols from the state health department that all schools are required to follow. Thank you!
- If your child forgets to wear a mask to school, have them visit the office. We have extra masks and we are happy to share. :)
- If you need to come to the school for any reason, please enter the front doors and don't go beyond the front entryway of the school. Visit the office for assistance.
- With school back in session 4 days a week, we have made adjustments to our recess schedule so there will be less students on the playground at one time. The new recess schedule is below. If you come to check out your child during their recess time or at lunch, you'll have to wait until their recess is over to check them out, so please work around this schedule.

- For Drop Off in the morning & Pick Up in the afternoon: Remember to **enter** in the **south driveway** of the church parking lot and **exit out** the **north driveway**. The flow of traffic won't work if cars are going the wrong direction. Please back in if you are going to park and wait.

You can send the wish list to extended family if you would like.

If you would like to order a book for your child's teacher, at checkout there is a box titled-"Special instructions for the Seller". This is where you can put which book or books in your order are for teachers, and if you want your child's name on a donation label in the book.

Books will be delivered to the school or you can pay for shipping to your home.

The purchased books will be given to your child to bring home unless you say that you will pick them up in the library.
