Distance Learning

Teachers are working hard to make sure that distance learning can continue. In light of the current situation, our school building will be restricted to essential staff only. Teachers that choose to leave materials for students will have them ready this Friday for pick up, March 27th or Monday, March 30th. (Some teachers may not have materials ready until Monday the 30th – please look for an email from the teacher to confirm when their materials are ready before coming to the school.) Because the building will be off limits and front doors will be locked, materials will be outside the front doors on tables. We encourage you as before, to pick them up quickly and return home without gathering to interact with others. As before, please arrive by last name between the following times:

A-G 9:00-10:00, H-L 10:00-11:00, M-S 11:00-12:00 and T-Z 12:00-1:00.

If these times are inconvenient, then come when possible, but between the hours of 9:00 and 1:00. Materials that haven't been picked up by Monday, March 30 at 1:00 P.M. will not be available for pickup again, so please make arrangements with a friend if you are unable to pick them up yourself. Exceptions will not be made for parents to enter the building at other times so that we can be in compliance with state guidelines.

Go to join.atozconnect.com and click on "sign up now". Enter the school zip code then select our school. If your email or phone number is in the database, a password reset link will be sent to your email. If not, complete the form to send in your join request. Only families with students have access to the directory.

Once we approve your request, you will get an email with login info. You can also download the AtoZconnect app from your app store.
