### **Spring Pictures**

This Thursday, April 15 will be our Spring Picture Day. Spring pictures are different than school pictures that are taken earlier in the year...the picture background is a more casual backdrop and students may dress in non-uniform clothing on April 15.

- Having your child's picture taken is totally optional.
- Fliers were sent home today with pricing information.
- Students may bring payment that day or pay ahead online. If you choose to prepay online, please write your order number on the flier envelope and send it with your child on Thursday.
- Pictures will not be taken of all students, only those that bring payment or have paid before the Spring Picture Day.
- Photographers will be at CRA to take pictures from 11:00-12:30 only.

### **Have Your Plans for Next Year Changed?**

If your plans have changed and your child won't be attending CRA next year because of a move or other family need, please let us know ASAP. We have begun inviting new lottery applicants and calculating our enrollment numbers for next year, and it's helpful to know if family situations are changing so that we can fill the spots vacated by students leaving the school. We hope you all stay!

### **Spring Time Reminders...**

Spring is a time when we all need a few reminders about procedures at CRA. Here are a few...

- Remember that our Uniform Policy has not changed...students should be dressed in the designated uniform clothing and colors. You can find our Dress Code Policy on the CRA website.
- Students are not allowed to use cell phones during school hours for calls or texting. This also applies to phone watches. If your student needs to contact you during the school day, they are welcome to use the school phone with the permission of their teacher.
- Spring in Utah brings inconsistent weather. Please make sure your child is dressed for the weather conditions and that they are prepared with warmer clothing if needed. We're probably not through wearing warm coats just yet, even if it is April. :)
- DROP off and PICK UP...
  - Do not drop off or pick up students in the front parking lot or on the street in front of the school (2900 East).
  - **Do** use the church parking lot, and remember to go IN the South entrance and OUT the North driveway. Not the other way around.
  - If cars are stopped, please don't go around them. If they are stopped, this usually means that students are loading or unloading, and going around cars to move into a perceived empty spot causes safety issues for the children. The children's safety should be the first priority during drop off and pick up.
