Hello Everyone,

As you know the remainder of the school year will continue as 'School at Home'. Our teachers will continue their lessons as they have been doing since the closure began. Our State Superintendent gave the following 3 guidelines for teachers working remotely: 1) do no harm, 2) go easy and 3) realize the stress (on students, families and teachers).

This is not easy for teachers to accomplish as in each classroom there are large differences in ability and different family situations that impact the time and effort that go into school at home. Again, the teachers are doing their best given all the dynamics involved.

I believe the State Superintendent's message applies to parents and students at this time also. We do not want this school at home time to create situations that can cause lasting harm to your family.
