Illness at School

With Covid concerns still upon us, there are a few guidelines we need to follow regarding illness at school. Attached is a flier from the Salt Lake County Health Department that gives a quick view of the guidelines we will follow concerning Covid exposure and quarantine.

We've also had some parents ask questions about other illnesses. Here are a few questions and answers that may help you decide when to keep your child at home when they are ill:

- Q: My child has a head cold but does not have Covid. When can my child return to school?
- A: As with any illness, your child should be free from symptoms/illness before returning to the classroom.
- Q: My child has complained about not feeling well but doesn't seem too ill. Can I send my child to school?
- A: If your child complains of body aches, stomach aches, headaches or other signs of illness, please keep your child at home until the symptoms of illness pass.
- Q: My child has allergies so he/she appears to be ill (runny nose, etc.). May I send my child to school with these symptoms?
- A: If your child has seasonal allergies, please communicate this with your child's teacher. Then when your child exhibits signs of illness due to allergies, the teacher will be aware of the source and concerns will be alleviated about exposing the rest of the class to a more serious illness.

Student Medication Needs

- If your child has medication (prescription or over the counter) needs during school hours, please visit the school office to set up the proper medical forms for your child's medication.
- Whether the med is dispensed by us or students carry their own inhaler, medical forms must be in place with the school office.
- Students are not allowed to carry medications to and from school, or have them on their person at school parents need to transport medications.
- Students that have asthma are the exception to that rule, and may carry inhalers in their backpacks. But... if your student has an inhaler at school, we need to be aware that they use it, and parents need to feel out a permission form for students to carry an inhaler.
