Often we get calls or emails from patrons asking many questions about school information. Here are some answers to questions we've been asked recently:

- CRA teachers and staff email addresses can be found on the website under the "Our Team" tab.
- School Spirit Shirts may only be worn on Fridays. (No Thursdays this year as we are back in session in-person five days a week.) Regular t-shirts are not a Friday option, only Spirit wear.
- Our Dress Code/Uniform Policy can be found on our website under "Our School".
- If there is a positive case of CoVid in your child's classroom, the administration will notify you through email. If you hear of cases in the school but have not been notified, then the positive CoVid case is not in your child's class.
- Because of the virus, we are cautious about welcoming visitors in the building. Parents are encouraged to come to the front entry way of the school and remain there instead of walking in the halls.
