Hello Everyone,

I have two items for you to review.

- The state has put the physical area of the school into the low risk/yellow health risk category. Luckily we are not in Salt Lake City boundaries where the risk is still moderate/orange category. *I have attached the updated guidelines from the state*. Of note is the last bullet point under K-12 schools. It says that more operational guidance will be coming from the State Board of Education. While we wait for this guidance from the state we are working on various scenarios to keep students, staff and visitors safe. We have learned a few things that we would do differently in the event we have to go back to school at home or other modifications to the school schedule.
- 2) Starting next week you will have the chance to pick up student's personal items and a school yearbook from the Multipurpose Room. You may enter and exit the outside door of the multipurpose room, next to the front doors. I want to thank the PTO for making the yearbook possible (among all the other things they have done) given the strange end to the school year! When you pick up the yearbook (one for each child), please check your child's name off the class list that will be on the table so we know which students picked them up.

If you have checked out a school computer, you may check it back in at this time.

If you'd like to leave anything for your teachers, you may put it on the teacher table.

I encourage you to follow this schedule as best as possible for social distancing purposes:

-Tuesday, May 26th is for families with last names starting with the letters A - F

-Wednesday the 27th is for families with last names from G - L

-Thursday the 28th is for families with last names from M - R

-Friday the 29th is for families with last names from S - Z

The Multipurpose Room will be open between 7:30 am to 4:00 pm
