-Discussed Math intervention: Bridges. Used by other schools, aligns with curriculum, including training, etc.

-This year's focus is math and student leadership. For many years we needed a tier 2 math intervention program, but couldn't find a satisfactory program.

Tier 1 - general classroom instruction

Tier 2 - additional support on top of the classroom. This happens in small groups during WIN time. Tier 2 targets specific skills and gaps in student learning. The goal is to get them going back into tier 1 only learning. Beyond this it's 1 on 1 or special education.

-Leadership focus: Leader in Me program provide values that align with our values. Concepts such as seeking a win-win, keep the end in mind, sharpening the saw, etc. Helps build an ability to work through conflict. This program has already started with teachers and will feed into all K-6. Training provided to teachers already, student counsel students will receive training next. We received a generous grant to fund this, the \$12K is the remainder that we need to pay for this year.

-Discussed simplifying the land trust needs to be more general, requiring less review and approval while still following the requirements of land trust. Propose 3 areas: Wages and Development \$55K, Academic Intervention \$30K, and Technology \$12,455.20.
