Goal 1 Increase the number of students reading at grade level. a) For grades 3-6, our goal is to increase the RISE ELA score by 2 percentage points from the previous year b) For 1st through 3rd grade our goal is to increase the Reading on Grade Level - Early Literacy score on the state report card by 2 percentage points from the previous year.

Measurements

- We will use the RISE Language Arts scores.
- We will use the Reading on Grade Level Early Literacy score on the state report card.

RISE testing scores from 2022 to 2023 in the area of ELA remained the same at 66% in both years. There was no increase nor decrease in our 3-6th grade scores. Regarding the Early Literacy scores on the state report card we scored "Average" with a 60% as compared to the state 62%.

Goal 2 Increase the number of students reaching proficiency in Math. Our goal is to increase the RISE Mathematics score by 2 percentage points from the previous year.

Measurements

• We will use the RISE Math scores.

According to Math RISE scores increased 65% to 69% for a total of 4 points from 2022 to 2023 in grades 3-6th. We exceeded this goal.

Teachers have worked to analyze math programs that we are using and upper grades have been completing a trial run of Eureka Squared with positive results. In math on the School report card we scored "High" with a 75% as compared to the state 62% average.

Goal 3 Our previous goal was to stabilize our RISE Science scores. Our goal is to increase our RISE Science score by 1 percentage point from the previous year.

Rise According to Science RISE scores increased 72% to 76% for a total of 4 points from 2022 to 2023 in grades 4-6th. We exceeded this goal.

According to the state report card we scored in the "high" range with a school average of 71% as compared to the stated average of 62%.
