A solid understanding of digital literacy, coding platforms, and STEM tools appropriate for K–6 learners is essential. Familiarity with Google Workspace, Canvas, or similar learning management systems is preferred. Strong communication skills, combined with a collaborative and flexible approach to working with both students and staff, are also important for success in this role.
