

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP PROCEDURES

Safety is our first priority. For this reason CRA has created a procedure for a drop-off and pick-up traffic pattern. Communicate this information to anyone who will be part of the pick-up and drop-off process. We all need to work together to maintain a safe and accessible procedure.

- There is one supervised drop-off and pick-up location. The Drop-off and Pick-up map outlines where cars are expected to enter and exit the drop-off and pick-up area. The arrows indicate the direction the vehicles should follow.
- There is a no parking zone in the traffic patterns to keep children safe, and avoid congestion and accidents.
- Do not enter the drive way north of the school; it is for bikes and walking students.
- Do not use the front parking lot or 2900 East, the street in front of the school, for drop-off and pick-up. The front parking lot is for faculty and parents entering the building only. 2900 East is narrow and needs to be kept clear for snow removal, pedestrian safety, and neighbor courtesy.
- We need every adult who is driving students to and from school to follow these procedures to protect the safety of every child.
