### **Vision Screening**

CRA Vision Screening is scheduled for Tuesday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>. Vision screening is not an eye exam – only a physician can diagnose and treat a patient for eye problems or glasses. In our vision screening students look at a chart to see if they can identify the pictures at a normal level of sight. Each year as we perform these screenings, we find several students that may be struggling with their vision, which can affect their ability to learn. Parents of students that may have trouble reading the chart will be notified after the screening.

We will be screening Kindergarten – 3<sup>rd</sup> graders. We can also screen students in grades 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> at the request of a parent.
