Kindergarten: Yellow

(balls, lemonade, corn tortilla chips, lemon drops, pineapple)

1st Grade: Kids Crafts

(crayons, paper, coloring books, scissors, markers, paint, colored pencils, colored paper, play-doh, erasers, stickers)

2nd Grade: Red

(red vines, cups, blankets, drinks, balls, candy, hats, bags, scarf)

3rd Grade: Camping/Outdoors

(ingredients for s'mores, chairs, water bottles, headlamps, batteries, first aid kit, mess kit, citronella candle, cooler, roasting sticks for hot dog or marshmallows, duffle bag, snacks)

4th Grade: Blue

(bubbles, candy, nail polish, cups, drinks, bag of balloons, crate paper, wrapping paper, ribbon, stuffed animals, blanket)

5th Grade: Family Movie Night

(movie tickets, popcorn, drinks, candy, videos, blanket, pillow)

6th Grade: Orange/Black

(Halloween decorations, balls, candy, drinks, fall decorations, nail polish, colored hair spray, socks, candles)
