Air Quality Concerns

As air quality becomes a concern in the winter months, we will be watching air quality reports each day.

There are many reporting stations around the valley – conditions vary from station to station. Sometimes when the conditions down in the valley are not good, air quality in the Canyon Rim area isn't as severe. The Utah Division of Air Quality has given the following recess guidelines regarding the Particulate Matter (PM) in the air to help schools know which levels are unsafe for outdoor recess.

- Green & Yellow air quality: all children may go outside for recess. (PM 2.5 below 35.5)
- Orange air quality: unsafe for children with asthma or breathing problems – those students may stay in for recess. (PM 2.5 below 55.4)
- Red air quality: unsafe for all students – entire student body will in stay in for recess. (PM 2.5 above 55.5)

CRA students remained indoors for the afternoon recess today as the air quality worsened throughout the day.

Parents, please shut your engines off while waiting in the pick-up line after school to help improve air quality. Thank you!

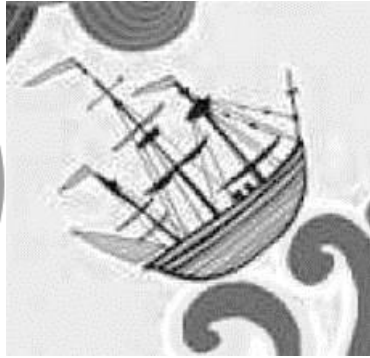
