Kindergarten Assessments

Each May our Kindergarten students participate in a state required Kindergarten Assessment, administered by their Kindergarten teacher. Appointments are 30 minutes long, and it takes several days for teachers to administer the assessment to every child as they meet with each child separately. To accommodate this assessment, Kindergarten and Kindergarten Enrichment classes will not be held May 13-17. Information on signing up for an assessment time will be sent to Kindergarten parents at the end of April, so watch for that email containing the link and instructions on how to sign up for an appointment time for your Kindergarten child.
