Board Brief for Monday, May 21, 2018

Our Annual Meeting was held Thursday, May 17th at 6:00 pm. We also held a regular board meeting from 4:00-6:00 pm that evening. We were pleased to have so many stakeholders and patrons in attendance at both meetings.

During the Q&A period, parents and teachers raised concerns broadly and about specific, personal situations. The board listened to all who cared to speak and responded in the meeting, as well as after, and has taken action to consider and improve several running themes of transparency, process, and role clarity. We look forward to continuing these conversations in the future.

Mr. Fuller updated the board and other members of the community on hiring updates for upcoming school year. Please see the most recent board minutes for more details. The Dibels scores for the school increased overall from 87, at the beginning of the school year, to 90 at the end of the year. A school-wide math program called Eureka will be adopted for the next school year; there will be professional development for teachers to help implement this new program as well as technology upgrades to help track student performance and growth. This will solve the vertical alignment gap in math. A strong mentoring program has been put into place, led by Peggy McCandless from the University of Utah; this program includes mentoring for teachers in their first three years of teaching as well as peer-to-peer

mentoring so that fellow teachers may observe one another. Mr. Fuller has observed every teacher formally and informally as part of teacher evaluations. Land Trust monies will be used to address technology needs in our SPED department. Teachers will also participate in professional development to continue to implement Core Knowledge into their curriculum. Mr. Fuller is going to capitalize on teacher's expertise by implementing a Distributive Leadership model at CRA; this will include Mandy Niles working on vertical alignment; Sean Thorpe will be getting his Gifted and Talented endorsement; and Rachel Lowry will help with data analysis and other items.

The CRA Board had two members rotate off the board at our Annual Meeting; Ruth Hadlock who has served as Secretary and Alyssa Larson who has served as our Academic Excellence liaison. CRA has benefitted immensely from their service and dedication to our school and we wish them the best in their future endeavors. The board welcomed Jason Esplin, who will begin his three-year term as a member of the board. The board voted to make the following changes: Alicia West will begin a two-year term as Secretary of the board; Becky Benham will begin a two-year term as Vice-Chair of the board; Erik Olson will continue to serve as Board Chair for one more year. The board also reviewed changes to their by-laws and unanimously approved the following changes: Each board member will serve no more than three, consecutive terms on the board of trustees; officer positions on the board will be one, two-year term.
