All projects must be received by 9:00 am on Friday, February 3, 2017.

Entries will be judged this year, so they must follow these rules,

General guidelines:

- All projects must be the original work of one or more students. If more than one student is involved, please list all names.
- Each entry MUST express the theme "Remember When..."
- Projects must include student's name and grade **on the back** of each project and on the back of each page of a literature entry—**please no names on the front of entries**
- Students may enter once in each category

Visual Arts

Visual Art:

- A visual arts entry could be an original print, drawing, painting, collage, print, etc
- Mounting on sturdy cardboard mat or poster board is encouraged
- Must not exceed 22 x 28 (poster board size) INCLUDING THE MOUNTING OR MATTING

3-D Art:

- 3-D art is visual art that has length, width, and breadth; including sculpture, ceramics, jewelry, mobiles, dioramas, fabric crafts, crocheting, weaving, etc
- Entries should not exceed a base of 22 x 28
- No kits or pre-cast ceramics

Photography:

- A photography entry must be a black-and-white or color image produced by a photographic process
- A student may submit a photo, a collage, or a retouched print
- The student must be the one to take the photograph
- MUST BE MOUNTED or MATTED on cardboard mat, poster board, or other sturdy material
- Must not exceed 11 x 14 INCLUDING THE MOUNTING OR MATTING

Literature:

- A literature entry may be work of fiction or nonfiction, prose, poetry, or an essay
- Entries must not exceed 1200 words
- Can be handwritten neatly or typed (one sided only) on 8 ½ x 11 paper with all pages numbered

Film Production:

- A film entry must be a student's original work of fiction or non-fiction; with or without sound.
- Can be Animation, Narrative, Documentary, or a Media Presentation
- NO PowerPoint presentations
- Student must be the director, screenwriter, and cameraperson
- Must not exceed 5 minutes

Performing Arts

Performing Arts entries can be uploaded to a private CRA YouTube channel. Please email kimdub35@gmail.com for instructions and a password. They can also be submitted on DVD.

Musical Composition:

- A musical composition entry may be voice, instruments, or a combination of both, created by the student
- If lyrics are included, please provide a written copy of the lyrics, stapled to the entry form
- Must not exceed 3 minutes

Dance:

- A dance entry must be an original dance composition choreographed by the student
- The choreographer may be the performer or one of the performers, but does not have to be
- Must not exceed 3 minutes
