Our committee of teachers, along with Mr. Fuller and Ms. Katina, Canyon Rim Academy's Licensed Clinical Social Worker, feels confident about the plan that has been proposed to begin an unprecedented school year. We want to express our gratitude for your patience during the summer. The committee has spent hours researching virus statistics, watching what nearby districts are planning for fall, looking at risk-mitigation data specific to our building, and meeting constantly; all with the hope of creating a plan that meets the needs of our Canyon Rim Academy community.

As a faculty, we have been thinking of ways to meet the needs of the whole child. This is something our school does so well. As teachers, we want to make sure we connect with each family individually before the year begins.
