## 2022-2023 Registration Information:

- \* Students must be 4 years old by August 31, 2022 and planning to attend Kindergarten the next year
- \* 4-day preschool program- Monday through Thursday
- \* Class time: 8:30 - 11:15 am
- \* Tuition: \$225.00 per month- due on the first day of each month
- \* Registration Fee: \$35.00 (non refundable)
- \* There is no uniform policy for Pre-school
- \* 18 students, 2 teachers and 1 or more parent volunteers each day  
We count on parents to help us in the classroom 7-8 times during the year. This can be a mom, dad, or grandparent. *Parent volunteers make all the difference!*

### Outline of Daily schedule:

Arrival, small motor tables, question of the day, hand washing

Circle time, busy bee assignments, counting, weather, introduce day, songs, books

Centers: 3 center small groups with learning activities

Circle time follow up. Book. Science and other large motor activities

Free time to explore and use our social skills. Clean up, hand washing

Snack time, gathering, outdoor recess, Pick up

## Calendar:

Canyon Prep Academy Preschool follows along with the Charter school calendar, and closely to the Granite School District calendar. Preschool will not be held on holidays and other school vacation days (Fall recess, teacher work days, Spring Break etc.) Snow days are when the area public/charter school classes are canceled because of weather conditions etc.

## Sick children:

In an effort to keep all of our students healthy, we will have each student wash their hands when they arrive at school. Please keep your child home if they are not feeling well. If they have a fever, tummy or bathroom issues, snotty nose and/or coughing it is better they stay home and get better.

## Bathroom use:

We are lucky to have our own bathroom for the children to use. All children must be fully potty-trained before school begins. This includes wiping, flushing and washing hands independently. If a child does have a bathroom accident, I will have a pair of sweatpants they can change into while I give you a call to come help them get cleaned up and changed.

More information and an orientation packet will be given at the parent meeting before school starts. I will be collecting immunization information at that meeting as well.
